


# Determining, consolidating and levelling pupils' literacy skills

A word from one of the authors: Noeline Pullen

'At the time of writing, there occurred—as often happens in education—a big push towards grammar and punctuation. It was felt that pupil knowledge in this area was lacking. Many teachers, themselves, did not have the literacy knowledge or confidence to support pupils.
